



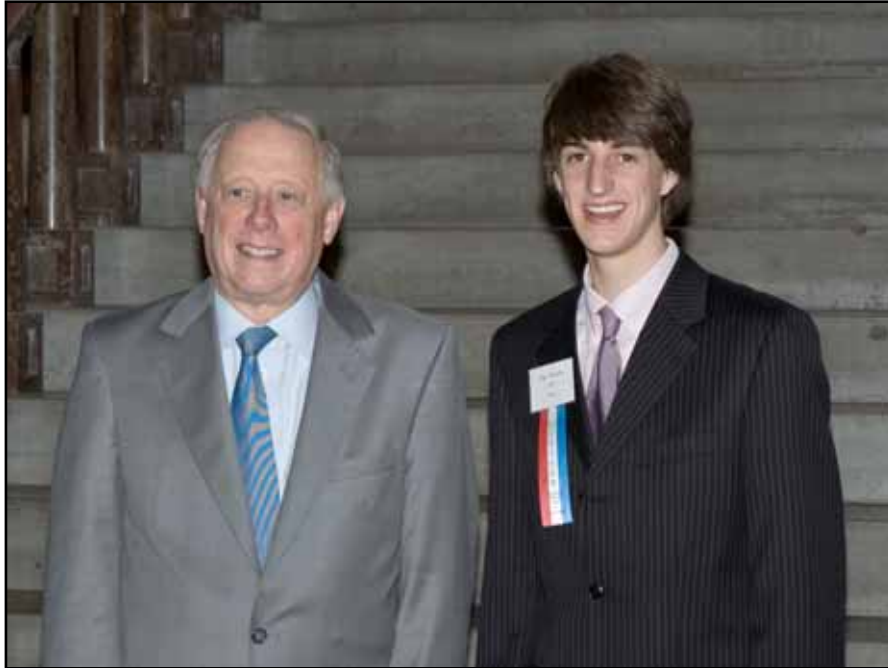

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Choose your own adventure payback...

Don't let anyone ever tell you that Youth in Government isn't exciting! Anyone who would say that obviously hasn't been around the epic battles that rage in the confines of our committees. Of those, none have brought about more controversy and debate at YIG '09 than Senate Bill #1, bill 9-1-1. This bill introduces a revolutionary take on crime and punishment by proposing that victims of crimes actually choose the punishments for the perpetrators of those crimes. The bill states that "victims will be provided with a range of acceptable punishments as correlative to the crime by the Supreme Court and sentencing hearing."

Public opinion varies rather astoundingly on this issue. Opinions are flying everywhere, ranging from enthusiastic support to outright hatred. Principally, the bill has been boldly labeled, "unconstitutional." It has been accused of violating the due process clause and defiling the criminal's right to trial by jury.

Darian Bruce of Gallatin High School, this conference's Attorney General, is a primary opponent of Senate Bill #1, vehemently claiming that "every person has the right to a fair trial and sentencing by an unbiased individual. The victim's family will invariably be emotionally unstable, and therefore be prone to issue an unsuitable, even unfair punishment."

Unquestionably, the defining word of the opposition is bias. Jury members themselves are selected for their utter lack of bias, because bias obscures judgment, and judgment is most assuredly needed in determining just punishment. This equal judgment is impossible from someone still stinging from the wounds dealt by crime, or so says Robert Vestal of MUS, the Solicitor General.

However, support for this bill continues to stand strong, even in the face of such crippling opposition, and who better to champion that support than the patrons themselves? Peyton

Trotter, one of the three original writers of the bill, proclaims her strong sentiment for human rights. She believes that anyone wronged in a crime should be guaranteed the right to retribution, which may well be the only happiness they can experience in the aftermath of a crime.

When asked about the brutal opposition to her bill so far, she asserted that "People just don't understand my bill, and I guess just haven't read it, because it clearly states that the Supreme Court must approve any punishments, which is more or less a guarantee of fairness and just punishment, and the only real way to avenge the crimes in the eyes of the victims."

Debate increased throughout the day as awareness of the bill spread by word of mouth, and the intensity is only going to keep rising as we head into tomorrow, where the bill will finally meet its fate in committee sometime in the afternoon.

Goodbye Youth Legislature?

Who read the cover of the bill books? Read it and recognize what it says: "Youth in Government". I thought this was Youth Legislature? Along with the change of name, the name of the organizer switched from "Youth Development Center" to "The YMCA Center for Civic Engagement". But, why make changes at the 56th annual conference?

Susan Moriarty, the conference director, said that the YMCA of middle TN has 33 centers. Youth programs used to fall under the umbrella of The Youth Development Center. In this center, there were 9 programs including YMCA Model UN and YMCA Youth Legislature.

Discussions to change were finalized in 2007. Moriarty says, "Because of the Y's strong commitment to these youth programs, we can now handle our own center." As of 2008, the Center for Civic Engagement manages Model UN and Youth in Government.

"As a whole, the new name Youth in Government seems to define all we do", says Moriarty, "with a name Youth Legislature, we would be limited to only a legislative branch. For example, without the Press, the public wouldn't have any idea what is going on. That is why it is important to not have a limited name."

From a student perspective, two members of the Red House spoke

their feelings regarding the new name. Neither delegates have a strong opinion regarding the new name. Tyler Mason of MJHS said, "I like the new name because it now corresponds with the name of our club, Youth in Government." Laura Walden of JP2 said, "Although it doesn't make any particular difference what the name is, Youth in Government has a cooler acronym than Youth Legislature. 'YIG' sounds much cooler than 'YL'."

In a nutshell, the change in title was done in good reasoning. Youth in Government will now encompass all aspects of the conference, not only the legislative component. All will be equal in the eyes of the YMCA.

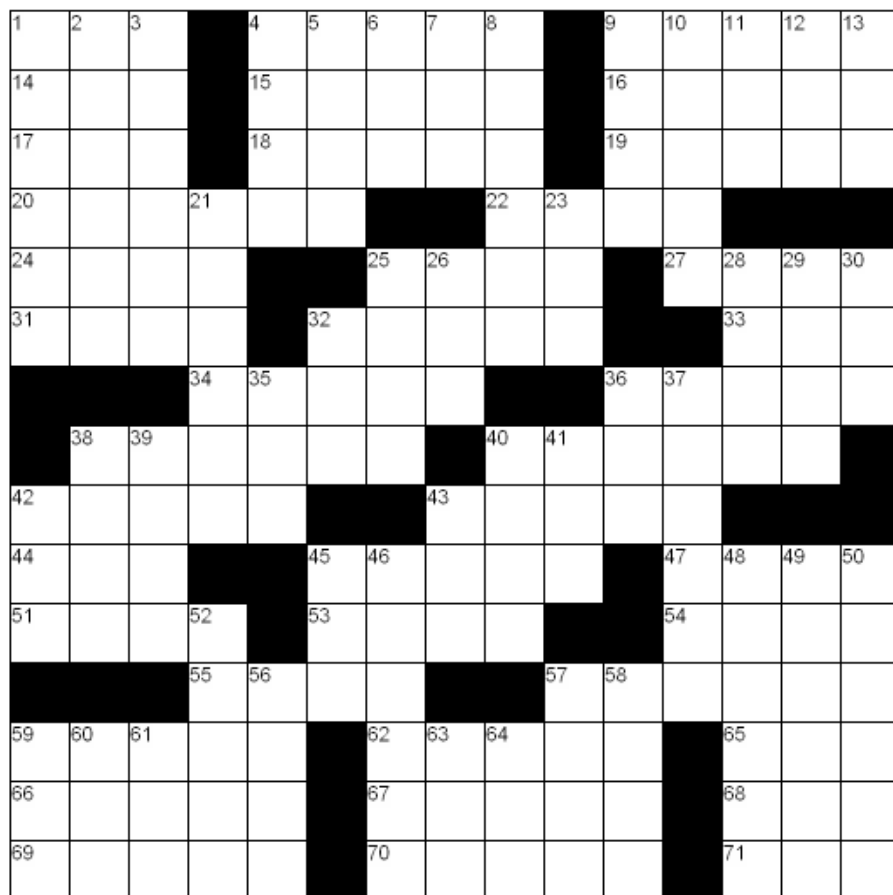
