

# **ELECTION GUIDELINES**

---

## **GUIDELINES FOR SCHOOLS:**

- No candidate will be eligible to seek the office of Security Council President or Security Council Vice President without having first served as a Security Council delegate.
- No school shall run more than a total of 6 candidates at the state election. Of these 6 candidates, no more than 2 may be for the office of General Assembly Vice-President.
- The offices of President of the International Court and ICJ Liason will be elected by the current ICJ at the conference. If you have students wishing to run for these offices, they DO NOT count toward your total number of candidates. Students may seek these ICJ offices even if you are already running 6 candidates in the state election. The same applies to the offices of Press Editor and Assistant Editor. They, too, will be elected by the current press corps at the conference.

## **GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES:**

- No candidate shall spend more than \$100.00 on materials to be used in his/her campaign.
- No candidate shall distribute candy or food of any kind.
- Any signs placed in common conference areas by candidates MUST be displayed on easels or other types of floor mounts. Nothing may be taped or otherwise affixed to hotel walls.
- Current officers MAY NOT display support for any candidates, unless they are themselves a candidate—in which case, they may campaign for themselves.
