Dear Youth in Government Advisor:

The 58th Annual Tennessee YMCA Youth in Government Conference is just days away, and we're anxiously awaiting the arrival of both you and your students. Hopefully this letter will answer any remaining questions you or your students might have about the conference, and if not, you know you can always give us a call—at this point, we're available pretty much 'round the clock!

❖ Please remind your students to bring with them a digital copy of their bill. We have tried very hard to check and double check to make certain no bill we received prior to printing has been left out of the book, but it is always a possibility, so it never hurts to have a copy on hand so that we might avert any small catastrophes.

SECURITY

Same story, different day...the Capitol Police have again asked us that you encourage your students not to carry backpacks, large bags or purses, etc., as all bags will be searched upon entry, and obviously, the bigger the bag, the longer the search. Also, any bags left behind inside or around the Capitol will be seized and removed, never to be seen again, so please tell your students to keep their items with them at all times, never leaving anything unattended.

Again, there will be only one entrance/exit available at the Capitol. All conference attendees will enter and exit through the revolving door at the entrance to Legislative Plaza. Here, just as last year, they will encounter state troopers and metal detectors. It is imperative that *every* delegate wears his/her nametag at *all times*. We have assured Capitol Police that all persons with our group will be identifiable by a nametag when they enter the building. In addition, *please make certain your students keep a photo I.D. on their person at all times*. Because of continued heightened security at all state office buildings, a photo I.D. is required for entry, and it's just a good idea to make sure all delegates have one handy. At the Capitol, they probably won't be asked to show it, but we want them to be prepared just in case. Occasionally the state troopers open the doors at the end of the LP tunnel exiting to Charlotte Ave. If these doors are open as students are EXITING the Capitol for meal breaks & dismissals, they may use them, but please instruct your students to ENTER always through the LP entrance we've always used.

*** HOTEL REGISTRATION**

Registration will take place on the Legislative Terrace of the Sheraton Hotel from 9:00-10:30 AM. During this time, please send an advisor to register your delegation, turn in any miscellaneous fees, and to pick up delegate bill books, nametags, and room keys if they're ready. As always, please do not go to the front desk to pick up your room keys. The Sheraton will bring all keys to our registration table on the terrace

*** LUGGAGE STORAGE**

The Davidson A Room will be available for luggage storage when you arrive. There will be signs designating areas for each school in the storage room. PLEASE make certain your students tag their luggage so we do not end up with someone grabbing the wrong suitcase.

* ROLLAWAY BEDS

Please be advised—some schools have put more than four students in a room. The hotel notified us that because of fire codes, they would not be able to honor requests for rollaway beds in double rooms. According to fire codes, rollaway beds can only be placed in King rooms, which are larger, with more pathways for exiting in the event of an emergency. All of that is to say, please make sure you tell your students in 5-person rooms that someone will need to bring blankets, air mattresses, etc. because the hotel will not be providing rollaway beds.

* ADVISOR MEETING/ AWARDS COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS

We will not hold an advisor meeting on Thursday morning! It simply rushes everyone to arrive early enough to attend, not everyone makes it, and it takes us away from the registration desk at a critically busy time. So, we have pre-assigned a teacher from every school to the Awards Committee. Every school is required to have a representative on the Awards Committee, but only one teacher is expected to serve, so if you have multiple teachers, it's perfectly fine if you want to take turns covering your committee so long as someone from your school is in there.

❖ COMPLIMENTARY ADVISOR DINNER

We would like to treat you to dinner on Thursday. There will be a buffet for all adults served on Legislative Terrace at 4:30 PM. Hopefully this will allow you to hold your 3:30 PM delegation meeting, get checked into your room and relax without having to leave the hotel for dinner.

❖ FIRST YEAR DELEGATE TRAINING

All first year delegates must attend the First Year Delegate meetings in the hotel ballroom at 10:30. Please make sure if you have any students to whom this applies, they know they have somewhere to be from 10:30 - 11:15.

❖ OPENING SESSION/CANDIDATE RECOGNTION

All candidates (except gubernatorial) are asked to meet in the front of the ballroom at 11:15AM. Candidates will be seated in the front of the ballroom in the chairs on either side of the stage, facing the audience.

Only candidates with opposition will be expected to give a speech. All candidates running unopposed will simply be introduced and asked to stand at their seat and be recognized.

❖ GOVERNOR'S BANQUET

The Governor's Banquet will be semi-formal dress again. Please make sure your delegates know they are required to attend. The menu is as follows:

Salad, Herb Crusted Chicken, Green Beans, Garlic Mashed Potatoes, Rolls and Cheesecake for desert.

Please note that the banquet is on Friday during Lent. Vegetarian meals will be available. Please complete the Vegetarian Request Form and turn that in to the info desk on Thursday during registration.

Again, a dance will follow the banquet. We will allow students a few minutes to return to their rooms to change if they so desire, but we will, as always, be monitoring the hallways to make certain that anyone who goes up does come down, and any help you could provide us with this would be greatly appreciated!

***** T-SHIRTS

Conference T-shirts will be sold for \$10.00. Shirts will be on sale, throughout the conference at the INFORMATION BOOTH.

* YIG BOWL

If you haven't registered a team for YIG Bowl you can still do so on the registration page of the website.

❖ INFORMATION BOOTH

Our fabulous, multi-talented college staff will again man the information booth. The booth will be located on the Legislative Terrace on Thursday night only. Throughout the duration of the conference, you will find it at the entrance to **Legislative Plaza**. All orders for pizza will need to be placed here as well.

❖ SATURDAY NIGHT DANCE THEME IS BLACK AND WHITE.

❖ GENERAL SAFETY

Please make sure you or another advisor monitors your delegates' whereabouts as they walk downtown for meal breaks. Nashville is a lovely city, but make sure your delegates know to stay alert and travel in groups to ensure their safety. We want everyone to be as safe as humanly possible during the conference, and common sense and taking steps like traveling in groups will help make that happen.

***** OTHER ITEMS OF NOTE

- ❖ Calls for wake-up calls jam the switchboard. Please advise your delegates to schedule them in advance, and not to wait until curfew to call.
- No iov riding on the elevator!
- Remind your students there will be NO component changes at the conference.
- ❖ Please make sure each of your delegates sign the code of conduct. You may turn those in to us on arrival if you have not already sent them.
- ❖ Please make a friendly reminder about the dress code. We will not hesitate to send a delegate to change if he or she is not in compliance with the dress code. Girls wearing uncomfortable dress shoes to walk downtown in is not an adequate excuse for wearing flip-flops, however, they may change into flip-flops once they

leave the Capitol if they so desire. They must don the dress shoes upon their return.

- * Remember, very few places are open for breakfast downtown on the weekend however Freshii, located on the corner of 5th and Church, is open on Saturday at 8AM and if you wear your nametag you get a 15% discount. You might also want to suggest to your students that they bring breakfast items for their room if they're big breakfast eaters.
- ❖ All officers MUST attend OFFICER TRAINING on WEDNESDAY before the conference. Please make sure all of your officers are aware of this and have taken care of their school-related absence issues in advance. They should report to the Sheraton Hotel Suite 4 at 10:00 AM.
- ❖ You may pay any remaining balance at the registration booth on arrival. If you have special circumstances with payment we are not aware of, now is the time to let us know. Remember, at this point, your school is liable for any balance listed on your summary sheet.
- * Please be sure to review the master roster and make certain all of your delegates are listed. Some students never registered online, so we took names directly from the bills. So, it is possible someone may have been left out, but if you do not let us know that immediately, they will likely arrive and have no nametag! If a student is listed in a legislative chamber and does not have a committee assignment that is an indication that we do not have their bill. Those schools to whom that applies have already been notified of the procedure for submitting still missing bills. Please attend to that matter ASAP. Wednesday before the conference starts IS NOT acceptable for this. We will already be at the hotel with the officers and CANNOT deal with missing bill issues once that day arrives.
- **❖** Pizza will be available each night for \$10.00. Large Cheese or Pepperoni.

 <u>Any students wishing to order pizza on THURSDAY night will need to place that order BEFORE committee meetings resume after the dinner break!</u>
- **❖** The official ballot is also being attached for your review. Please make certain IMMEDIATELY that it contains no mistakes or omissions. Those will be very difficult to remedy once the election commission sets up the machines.
- **Please remind your students to tip hotel staff appropriately.**
